

# Minimal Working Example of the `\hyperfootnote` command

Have a look at my website<sup>1</sup>!

You will notice that while a short URL is shown in the footnote, both the clickable text in the paragraph and the footnote itself link to the full URL, i.e. including ‘`http://`’ or ‘`https://`’, which you add as an optional argument.

You can also have non-clickable text<sup>2</sup> with a full clickable link as footnote if you prefer.

Syntax:

```
\hyperfootnote[<optional text>][<optional invisible URL prefix>]{URL}
```

E.g.

```
\hyperfootnote[my website][http://]{www.brechtdeман.com}
```

```
\hyperfootnote{https://www.latex-project.org}
```

Therefore,

```
\href{http://www.brechtdeман.com}{my website}
```

```
\footnote{\href {http://www.brechtdeман.com}{www.brechtdeман.com}}
```

can be replaced by

```
\hyperfootnote[my website][http://]{www.brechtdeман.com}
```
